	<u>time frame:</u> 1 hour
	<u>location:</u> a room
	<u>participants:</u> 6 – 20
	<u>material:</u> The Declaration of Human Rights, www.un.org/Overview/rights.html
	<u>procedure:</u> The group is given a leaflet of the Declaration of Human Rights. The group shall decide about the 3 most important articles which they feel that the human rights are not implemented or they are violated in their country.
	<u>goal / purpose:</u> To inform participants about human rights and to raise their assertiveness.
	<u>Questions for discussion:</u> 1) How much do we know our rights? 2) What are we doing for them? 3) How much we consider the social and the personal responsibility?
