









Spider Net

	<p><u>time frame:</u> ~ 15-25 min</p>
	<p><u>location:</u> in- and outdoors</p>
	<p><u>participants:</u> up to 10 people</p>
	<p><u>material:</u> rope, ribbon</p>
	<p><u>procedure:</u> A spider net is stretched between two trees by using a rope or ribbon. The net should be at least 2 meters high. The number of the participants and the number of the holes in the net have to be identical.</p>
	<p><u>goal / purpose:</u> The challenge for the group is to get all members through the net without touching it. If the net is touched the whole group (optional: only the person who has touched the net) has to start from the beginning. Those who have reached the goal are not allowed to go back to the other side in order to help the others. Help can only be provided from the side where one actually stands.</p>
	<p><u>Questions for discussion:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Did you first discuss the solution or did you start to act right away? - How narrow were the rules?
